Water's Edge 2010: A Vancouver 2010 Cultural Olympiad presentation

Coquitlam, BC – For the second year, Coastal Sound Music Academy and the Evergreen Cultural Centre have partnered with Vancouver 2010 Cultural Olympiad to present this world-class festival of music taking place March 19 – 21, 2010 at the Evergreen Cultural Centre.

Three main stage concerts headline this year's festival including the **Elektra Women's Choir** with opening performance by Voca Java, acclaimed vocal ensemble **musica intima** and the world premiere of the “Bard Turner Project” a new work by Juno-award winning musician **Brad Turner** commissioned specifically for Water's Edge.

Over the course of three days, Water's Edge will not only offer outstanding music, but many hands-on activities for all ages. Bring your guitar and your enthusiasm for the All Canadian Guitar Jam, join a drumming circle or participate in several workshops, such as lantern making, artist trading cards and pottery. Tots can visit the instrument petting zoo or explore music and song play. Be sure to check out the website for up-to-the-minute information.

“We encourage the community to come by, once or several times,” says Artistic Director Diana Clark. “There is bound to be some new music, new artists and new musical genres for everyone to discover.
